Who are we naturally good at seeing, welcoming, or serving within our community?

Who might be close to us physically or relationally, yet we still struggle to progress anything spiritually?

Where are we seeing a harvest, with people growing as disciples?

Where are we ploughing the ground and building relationships that may not yet show visible fruit?

Where are we sowing seeds of faith and beginning to share something of the Christian story?

Where are we noticing green shoots — people asking questions and starting to explore faith more deeply?

Where have you seen small signs of growth, connection, or transformation that could be easy to overlook?

Where are people, places, or spaces where we currently have little or no impact, and why might that be?

What aspects of mission do you feel personally confident in, and where do you feel hesitant or unsure?

Where do you feel most encouraged missionally, and where do you feel discouraged?

How comfortable are we with stopping to ask whether something in the life of the church is still serving its purpose?

What do you think is working well missionally, and is there anything that doesn't seem to be working as hoped?

What might we need to stop, start, or change to make room for new connections and growth?

As we look back over the past year and ahead to the next season, where are you seeing God at work, and what do you sense God may be inviting us into next?
